CHAPTER 29

OXFORD AND CAMBRIDGE ACT 1571

- [I.] The Chancellor, Masters, and Scholars of the University of Oxford incorporated; Common Seal; The Chancellor, Masters, and Scholars of the Universities of Cambridge incorporated; Common Seal;
- II Letters Patent 1 Ap. 14 H. VIII. to University of Oxford, and 26 Ap. 3 Eliz. to University of Cambridge, and all other Letters Patents to either of the said Universities, confirmed.
- III All Possessions and Privileges of the said Universities confirmed to them, being so incorporated.
- IV All Deeds, Obligations, &c. made to the said Universities, by any former Description, declared valid.
- V Patents and Liberties granted the Universities, by any former Description, declared valid, and ratified.
- VI Proviso for Titles of Strangers, Lessees, &c.
- VII Proviso for Liberties of Mayor, Bailiffs, and Burgesses of Cambridge and Oxford.
