1688 CHAPTER 2 1 Will and Mar Sess 2

II Non obstantes made void.

Noe Dispensation by Non obstante of or to any Statute or any part thereof shall be allowed but the same shall be held void and of noe effect Except a Dispensation be allowed of in such Statute . . . ^{F1}
