OPERATION OF ENACTMENTS

27 Operation of declaration that provisions are to cease to have effect.

- (1) Where in an enactment it is declared that the whole or a part of any [^{F1}statutory] provision is to cease to have effect, that [^{F1}statutory] provision shall be deemed to have been repealed to the extent to which it is so declared to cease to have effect.
- (2) Sub-section (1) shall not be taken to prejudice the operation of any declaration in an enactment that the whole or a part of any [^{F1}statutory] provision is repealed.
