

Powers of Attorney Act (Northern Ireland) 1971

1971 CHAPTER 33

8 Delivery of power of attorney relating to unregistered land to purchaser.

Notwithstanding any stipulation to the contrary, a purchaser of any interest in or charge upon unregistered land is entitled to have any instrument creating a power of attorney which affects his title, or a copy thereof or of the material portions thereof, delivered to him free of expense.
