PERSONS WHO LACK CAPACITY

General powers of the court and appointment of deputies

15 Power to make declarations

- (1) The court may make declarations as to—
 - (a) whether a person has or lacks capacity to make a decision specified in the declaration;
 - (b) whether a person has or lacks capacity to make decisions on such matters as are described in the declaration;
 - (c) the lawfulness or otherwise of any act done, or yet to be done, in relation to that person.
- (2) “Act” includes an omission and a course of conduct.
