3. Persons may be appointed as whole-time or part-time members of the[^{F1} Executive].

4. Subject to paragraphs 5 and 6 a person shall hold and vacate office as chairman $[^{F2}$, deputy chairman] or member of the $[^{F2}$ Executive] in accordance with the terms of his appointment.

5. A person may at any time resign office as chairman[^{F3}, deputy chairman] or member of the[^{F3} Executive] by notice in writing to the Department.

6.—(1) The Head of the Department may at any time remove a person from office as chairman[^{F4}, deputy chairman] or member of the[^{F4} Executive] if satisfied that—

- (a) he has been absent from meetings of the[^{F4} Executive] for a period longer than six consecutive months without the permission of the[^{F4} Executive]; or
- (b) he has been convicted of a criminal offence; or
- (c) he has become bankrupt [^{F5} or is the subject of a bankruptcy restrictions order][^{F6} or a debt relief order has been made in respect of him or he is the subject of a debt relief restrictions order] or made an arrangement with his creditors; or
- (d) he is incapacitated by physical or mental illness; or
- (e) he is otherwise unable or unfit to perform his duties.

(2) If the chairman[^{F4} or deputy chairman] ceases to be a member of the[^{F4} Executive] he shall also cease to be chairman[^{F4} or, as the case may be, deputy chairman].
