**The Appropriation (No. 3)  
(Northern Ireland) Order 1986**

*Laid before Parliament in draft*

*Made* 16th December 1986

*Coming into Operation* 16th December 1986

At the Court at Buckingham Palace, the 16th day of December 1986

Present,

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Whereas a draft of this Order has been approved by a resolution of each House of Parliament:

Now, therefore, Her Majesty, in exercise of the powers conferred by paragraph 1 of Schedule 1 to the Northern Ireland Act 1974 and of all other powers enabling Her in that behalf, is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:— 1974 c. 28

*Title and commencement*

**1.** This Order may be cited as the Appropriation (No. 3) (Northern Ireland) Order 1986 and shall come into operation forthwith.

*Interpretation*

**2.** The Interpretation Act (Northern Ireland) 1954 shall apply to Article 1 and the following provisions of this Order as it applies to a Measure of the Northern Ireland Assembly. 1954 c. 33 (N.I.)

*Issue of sum out of the Consolidated Fund for year ending on 31st March 1987*

**3.** The Department of Finance and Personnel may issue out of the Consolidated Fund and apply towards making good the supply granted to Her Majesty for the service of the year ending on 31st March 1987 the sum of fifty million, five hundred thousand pounds.

**THE APPROPRIATION (NO. 3) (NI) ORDER 1986**  
**SI 1986/2227 (NI 22)**

*Power for Department of Finance and Personnel to borrow* \*

4.—(1) Subject to paragraph (2), the Department of Finance and Personnel may borrow on the credit of the aforesaid sum, any sum or sums not exceeding in the whole twenty-five million pounds. \*

(2) Any money so borrowed shall be repaid, with any interest due thereon, out of the Consolidated Fund at any date not later than 31st March 1987.

*Appropriation of grant*

5.—(1) The sum granted by Article 3 out of the Consolidated Fund is appropriated for the service and purpose expressed in Schedule 1.

(2) The sum already authorised to be appropriated in aid for the year ending on 31st March 1987 shall be decreased by the sum specified in the third column of Schedule 1 for the service in connection with which that sum is specified.

*Repeal of spent enactments*

6. The enactments mentioned in Schedule 2 are hereby repealed to the extent specified in the third column of that Schedule.
