ROAD TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES

Public Service Vehicles (Amendment) Regulations
(Northern Ireland) 1995

Made 4th December 1995

Coming into operation 24th January 1996

The Department of the Environment, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Articles 61(1), 66(1), 80 and 218(1) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(a) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Public Service Vehicles (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1995 and shall come into operation on 24th January 1996.

Amendment of the Public Service Vehicles Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1985

2. The Public Service Vehicles Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1985(b) shall be amended as follows—

(1) In regulation 3(1) (interpretation)—

(a) in the definition of “bus” for the words “six persons” there shall be substituted “eight passengers”;

(b) after the definition of “the Community Recording Equipment Regulation” there shall be inserted the following definition—

“ “the Conditions of Fitness Regulations” means the Public Service Vehicles (Conditions of Fitness, Equipment and Use) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1995(c);”;

(c) after the definition of “the Order” there shall be inserted the following definition—

“ “the 1995 Order” means the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1995(d);” and

(d) in the definition of “taxi” for the words “six passengers” there shall be substituted “eight passengers”.

(2) In regulation 6 (inspection of vehicle and grant of licence)—

(a) in paragraph 2(a) for the words “relating to the construction and condition of motor vehicles, their accessories and equipment;” there shall be substituted “; and”;

(b) at the end of paragraph (2)(b) “; and” shall be omitted and a comma inserted;

(c) paragraph (2)(c) shall be omitted;

(d) in paragraph (3) for the words “regulations 18 and 20 and, save in the case of a vehicle mentioned in regulation 22” there shall be substituted “regulations 61 and 62 of the Conditions of Fitness Regulations and, save in the case of a vehicle mentioned in regulation 63 of those Regulations”; and

(e) for paragraph (4) there shall be substituted—

“(4) For the purposes of paragraph (2) “the statutory requirements” means the Conditions of Fitness Regulations; the Motor Vehicles (Construction and Use) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1989(a); the Road Vehicles (Registration and Licensing) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1973(b) and the Road Vehicles Lighting Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1995(c) and the inspection shall include the items in Schedule 3 applicable to the vehicle being inspected.”

(3) In regulation 7 (licence and disc) in paragraph (2) for the words “an inspector of vehicles shall affix a disc to the vehicle” there shall be substituted “the Department shall issue a disc for the vehicle”.

(4) In regulation 10 (refund of fees), in paragraph (2), in the definition of “exceptional circumstances”, the words “an epidemic, severe weather,” shall be omitted.

(5) In regulation 12 (duplicate licence or disc), in paragraph (1), and in regulation 16 (change of address of licensee), for the word “owner” there shall be substituted “licensee”.

(6) In regulation 13 (conditions of licence)—

(a) at the end of paragraph (j) there shall be omitted the word “and”;

(b) at the end of paragraph (k) for the words “regulation 39(2)(b).” there shall be substituted “regulation 46(14)(b) of the Conditions of Fitness Regulations; and”;

(c) after paragraph (k) there shall be added the following paragraph—

“(l) shall not remove or tamper with any seal affixed to a taximeter.”.

(7) In regulation 17 (revocation or suspension of licence)—

(a) in paragraph (1) for sub-paragraph (e) there shall be substituted the following sub-paragraph—

“(e) on a test under Article 75(1) of the 1995 Order non-compliance with the statutory requirements relating to the use, construction or condition of the vehicle are found by a vehicle examiner.”; and

(b) in paragraph (3) for the words “an inspector of vehicles issues a notice of prohibition under Article 36(1) of the Order” there shall be substituted “a vehicle examiner imposes a notice of prohibition under Article 77(6) of the 1995 Order”.

(8) Regulations 18, 20, 22, 35 to 46 and Schedules 8 and 10 shall cease to have effect.

(This note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations further amend the Public Service Vehicles Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1985 as follows—

1. (a) “Bus” is now defined as a vehicle seating more than eight passengers in addition to the driver (previously six persons in addition to the driver); and
(b) “taxi” is now defined as a vehicle seating not more than eight passengers in addition to the driver (previously six passengers in addition to the driver) (regulation 2(1)).
2. The regulations relating to the grant of a licence and the issue of a licence and disc have been redrafted so as to—
 - (a) specify the Regulations comprising the statutory requirements with which a vehicle must comply; and
 - (b) replace the provision that on the grant of a licence an inspector of vehicles shall affix a disc to the vehicle with a provision that on the grant of a licence a disc shall be issued for the vehicle (regulation 2(2) and (3)).
3. Epidemic and severe weather have been deleted from the list of circumstances which may satisfy the Department that the vehicle either cannot or could not reasonably be expected to be presented for inspection (regulation 2(4)).
4. References to the owner of a vehicle have been changed to references to the licensee (regulation 2(5)).
5. An addition has been made to the conditions upon which a licence is granted, namely that a seal affixed to a taximeter must not be removed or tampered with (regulation 2(6)).
6. References to an inspector of vehicles have been changed to references to a vehicle examiner (regulation 2(7)).
7. Regulations relating to maximum seating and standing capacity, taximeters, markings on vehicles, roof signs, repair outfit, fire extinguishing apparatus, destination boards, obstructions, inflammable spirit and drawing of trailers shall cease to have effect (regulation 2(8)).
