The Secretary of State makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 87 of the Justice (Northern Ireland) Act 2002⁽¹⁾.

1. This Order may be cited as the Justice (Northern Ireland) Act 2002 (Commencement No.12) Order 2007.
2. The provisions of the Justice (Northern Ireland) Act 2002 specified in the Schedule to this Order shall come into force on 16th April 2007.

Article 2

PROVISIONS OF THE JUSTICE (NORTHERN IRELAND)
ACT 2002 COMING INTO FORCE ON 16TH APRIL 2007
