REGULATION MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE WITH THE CONCURRENCE OF THE LORD CHIEF JUSTICE AND THE SPEAKERS OF THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF COMMONS OF NORTHERN IRELAND IN PURSUANCE OF THE RULES PUBLICATION ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1925.

The Ministry of Finance, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by Sections one and two of the Rules Publication Act (Northern Ireland), 1925 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and with the concurrence of the Lord Chief Justice of Northern Ireland and the Speakers of the Senate and the House of Commons of Northern Ireland as required by the Act, hereby makes the following regulation :—

The Unemployment Assistance Board of Northern Ireland being an authority to which paragraph (f) of sub-section (2) of section 2 of the Act applies, is hereby prescribed as a rule making authority for the purposes of the Act in respect of any statutory rules of a public nature made by it.
