

JUDGMENTS (ENFORCEMENT) ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1969**Date of Commencement**

ORDER, DATED 7TH DECEMBER 1970, MADE BY THE MINISTER OF HOME AFFAIRS UNDER SECTION 133(2) OF THE JUDGMENTS (ENFORCEMENT) ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1969.

I, Major the Right Honourable James Dawson Chichester-Clark, D.L., Minister of Home Affairs for Northern Ireland, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 133(2) of the Judgments (Enforcement) Act (Northern Ireland) 1969(a), hereinafter referred to as "the Act", do hereby order as follows:—

Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Judgments (Enforcement) Act (Northern Ireland) 1969 (Date of Commencement) Order 1970.

Date of commencement

4. The Act shall come into operation on 15th February 1971.

Poultry Testing (Revocation)

SCHEME, DATED 3RD DECEMBER 1970, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE UNDER SECTION 9 OF THE AGRICULTURE ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1949.

The Ministry of Agriculture in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Section 9(1) of the Agriculture Act (Northern Ireland) 1949(a) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf and with the approval of the Ministry of Finance hereby makes the following Scheme:—

Citation and Commencement

1. This Scheme may be cited as the Poultry Testing (Revocation) Scheme (Northern Ireland) 1970 and shall come into operation on the 1st January 1971.

Revocation

2. The Poultry Testing Scheme (Northern Ireland) 1967(b) as amended by the Poultry Testing (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1968(c) is hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Scheme but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

This Scheme revokes entirely the Poultry Testing Scheme under which the Ministry of Agriculture carried out tests at the Poultry Testing Station, Gosford, to demonstrate the relative qualities of those strains of laying poultry which are available to commercial egg producers.
