## HOUSING

### Housing Subsidy Order

ORDER, DATED 14TH DECEMBER 1973, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF DEVELOPMENT, WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE, UNDER SECTION 1 OF THE HOUSING (NO. 2) ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1946.

The Ministry of Development (in this Order referred to as "the Ministry") with the approval of the Ministry of Finance, and on behalf of the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on the Ministry by section 1. of the Housing (No. 2) Act (Northern Ireland) 1946(a), and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Housing Subsidy (Variation) (No. 4) Order (Northern Ireland) 1973 and shall be construed as one with the Housing Subsidy Order (Northern Ireland) 1962(b).

2. In its application to a housing scheme in respect of which the tender has been submitted for approval to the Ministry by the Northern Ireland Housing Executive or accepted by a Housing Association after 15th December, 1973, the Housing Subsidy Order (Northern Ireland) 1962 shall be amended by substituting for the Schedule therein the Schedule to this Order.
