Royal Ulster Constabulary (Amendment) Regulations

REGULATIONS, DATED 20TH DECEMBER 1973, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS UNDER SECTION 25 OF THE POLICE ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1970.

The Ministry of Home Affairs for Northern Ireland, with the concurrence of the Ministry of Finance and on behalf of the Secretary of State, and in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 25 of the Police Act (Northern Ireland) 1970(a) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf and after consulting, in accordance with section 34(2) of the said Act, the Police Authority and the Police Association and, in accordance with section 4 of the Police Act 1969(b) the Police Council for the United Kingdom, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

Citation and interpretation

- 1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Royal Ulster Constabulary (Amendment) (No. 4) Regulations 1973.
- (2) In these Regulations the expression "Principal Regulations" means the Royal Ulster Constabulary Regulations 1973(c).

Effect

- 2.—(1) Regulation 4 of these Regulations and paragraph 1(1), inserted by Regulation 5 of these Regulations, in Part 1 of Schedule 4 to the Principal Regulations (relating to the pay of senior officers), shall have effect from 1st April 1973.
- (2) Paragraph 1 (1A), inserted by Regulation 5 of these Regulations, in Part 1 of Schedule 4 to the Principal Regulations (relating to the pay of members in the ranks set out in Table B in the said Part 1) shall have effect from 1st September 1973.

Amendment to Regulation 4 of the Principal Regulations

3. In Regulation 4 of the Principal Regulations (definitions) the definition "public holiday" shall be amended as follows:—

after the word "means" there shall be inserted the words "New Year's Day,".

Amendment to Regulation 28 of the Principal Regulations

4. In Regulation 28(2) of the Principal Regulations (scales and conditions of pay) the letter "A" where it first occurs shall be omitted.

Amendment to Schedule 4 to the Principal Regulations

5. For paragragh 1(1) of Part 1 of Schedule 4 to the Principal Regulations (scales of pay) there shall be substituted the following paragraphs:—

⁽a) 1970. c. 9 (N.I.).

⁽b) 1969. c. 63.

- "1.—(1) The annual pay of a man holding a rank above that of constable, being neither a superintendent nor a rank mentioned in Table B, shall be such as shall be determined by the Ministry with the approval of the Ministry of Finance.
- (1A) The annual pay of a man holding a rank referred to in the following Table B shall, subject as hereinafter in this Schedule provided, be determined in accordance with the appropriate scale set out in that Table."

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

Regulation 3 amends Regulation 4 of the Principal Regulations and includes New Year's Day in those days designated as public holidays.

Regulations 4 and 5 amend the Regulations of 1973 by providing that the pay of the chief, deputy and assistant chief constables shall be as approved by the Ministry with the consent of the Ministry of Finance.
