POLICE**Police Act (Northern Ireland) 1970: Appointed Day**

ORDER, DATED 31ST DECEMBER 1973, MADE BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE UNDER SECTION 36(2) OF THE POLICE ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1970.

In exercise of the power conferred on me by section 36(2) of the Police Act (Northern Ireland) 1970(a) (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and section 1(1) of the Northern Ireland (Temporary Provisions) Act 1972(b), I hereby order as follows:—

Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Police Act (Northern Ireland) 1970 (Appointed Day) (No. 2) Order 1973.

Appointed day

2. The following provisions of the Act shall come into operation on 1st January 1974, that is to say:—

Section 33(2) and Schedule 4 in so far as they repeal the Special Constables (Ireland) Act 1832(c), the Special Constables Act 1914(d), section 4 of the Constabulary and Police (Ireland) Act 1919(e) and section 2 of the Constabulary Act (Northern Ireland) 1922(f) in so far as the said sections 4 and 2 are unrepealed, section 8 of the said Act of 1922, and the Constabulary (Pensions) Act (Northern Ireland) 1949(g):

Provided that the repeal hereby effected of the Special Constables Act 1914, section 4 of the Constabulary and Police (Ireland) Act 1919 and section 8 of the Constabulary Act (Northern Ireland) 1922 shall not extend to the power to make regulations with respect to pensions, gratuities and compensation in relation to service in the Ulster Special Constabulary.
