**The Public Records (Scotland) Act 2011 (Authorities)
Amendment Order 2018**

Made - - - - - *2018*
Coming into force - - - *12th January 2018*

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 2(2) of the Public Records (Scotland) Act 2011(a) and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 2(8) of that Act, a draft of this Order has been laid before and approved by resolution of the Scottish Parliament(b).

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Public Records (Scotland) Act 2011 (Authorities) Amendment Order 2018 and comes into force on 12th January 2018.

Amendments to the schedule to the Public Records (Scotland) Act 2011

2. In the schedule of the Public Records (Scotland) Act 2011 (authorities to which Part 1 of that Act applies), under the heading “Others”, in the appropriate place according to alphabetical order, add the following entries—

“First-tier Tribunal for Scotland”; and

“Upper Tribunal for Scotland”.

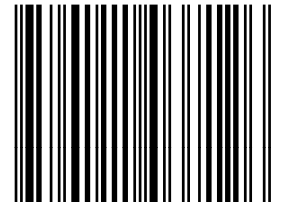
