**The Ethical Standards in Public Life etc. (Scotland) Act 2000

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 32(1) of the Ethical Standards in Public Life etc. (Scotland) Act 2000^(a) and all other powers enabling them to do so.

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Ethical Standards in Public Life etc. (Scotland) Act 2000 (Codes of Conduct for Members of certain Scottish Public Authorities) Amendment Order 2024 and comes into force on 1 April 2024.
