## SCHEDULE 1

PROVISIONS AS TO THE RACE RELATIONS BOARD AND CONCILIATION COMMITTEES.

## The Race Relations Board

- The Race Relations Board shall be a body corporate having perpetual succession and a common seal.
- A person appointed to be a member of the Board shall hold and vacate office under the terms of the instrument by which he is appointed, but may at any time resign his office; and a person who ceases to hold office as a member of the Board shall be eligible for reappointment.
- The Board may appoint such officers and servants as they may, after consultation with the Secretary of State and with the consent of the Treasury, determine; and the Board shall be included among the bodies listed in Schedule 8 to the Superannuation Act 1965.
- 4 (1) The Secretary of State shall pay to the members of the Board such remuneration and allowances as he may, with the consent of the Treasury, determine.
  - (2) The Board shall pay to any assessors appointed by them under section 18 of this Act and to the officers and servants of the Board such remuneration and allowances as they may, with the consent of the Treasury and after consultation with the Secretary of State, determine.
- There shall be defrayed out of moneys provided by Parliament the expenses of the Secretary of State under paragraph 4(1) of this Schedule, together with the expenses of the Board under paragraph 4(2) thereof and, to such amount as the Secretary of State may with the consent of the Treasury approve, any other expenses of the Board.
