Amalgamation or transfer of engagements

104 Appeal from decision of Certification Officer.

An appeal lies to the Employment Appeal Tribunal, at the instance of the complainant or the trade union, [^{F1}on any question arising] in any proceedings before, or arising from any decision of, the Certification Officer under section 103.
