# PART I

### THE GENERAL COUNCIL

## Members elected by fully registered osteopaths

- 9 (1) This paragraph and paragraph 10 apply in relation to the 12 members elected by fully registered osteopaths.
  - (2) Each member
    - shall be a fully registered osteopath at the time of his election, and (a)
    - may be a registered medical practitioner. (b)
  - (3) One member shall be expressly elected as a member who is both a fully registered osteopath and a registered medical practitioner at the time of his election.
  - (4) The member mentioned in sub-paragraph (3) shall be elected by fully registered osteopaths whose registered addresses are in the United Kingdom.
  - (5) Of the other 11 members—
    - 8 shall be elected by fully registered osteopaths whose registered addresses (a) are in England;
    - 1 shall be elected by fully registered osteopaths whose registered addresses (b) are in Wales;
    - 1 shall be elected by fully registered osteopaths whose registered addresses (c) are in Scotland; and
    - 1 shall be elected by fully registered osteopaths whose registered addresses (d) are in Northern Ireland.
- 10 The General Council shall make further provision by rules in relation to the election of the 12 members and as to by-elections.
