 - (i) in the case of the [F2provision mentioned in paragraph (i)] of that Table, by the Secretary of State;
 - (ii) in the case of the provision mentioned in paragraph (vi) of that Table, by the Lord Chancellor or by the Secretary of State or by both acting jointly;
 - (iii) in the case of the provision mentioned in paragraph (vii) of that Table, by the Treasury; and
 - (iv) in the case of the provisions mentioned in paragraphs (viii) to (x) of that Table, by the appropriate Minister (within the meaning of section 30(1) of the M5 Judicial Pensions and Retirement Act 1993); and
- (b) in the case mentioned in paragraph (b) of that sub-paragraph, the day appointed as the day on which that provision is to come into force.

(4) An order under sub-paragraph (3) may—

- (a) appoint different days for different provisions or for different purposes of the same provision;
- (b) in the case of an order appointing a day until which paragraph 2 has effect, may make such transitional provision or savings as appear to the Secretary of State to be necessary or expedient in connection with section 163(9), and may make such adaptations of that section or of any provision of this Act
