##### PART I

##### THE COMMISSIONER

##### *Money*

- 8 The Secretary of State may make payments to the Commissioner out of money provided by Parliament.
- 9 (1) All fees and other sums received by the Commissioner in the exercise of his functions under this Act or section 159 of the <sup>M1</sup>Consumer Credit Act 1974 shall be paid by him to the Secretary of State.
- (2) Sub-paragraph (1) shall not apply where the Secretary of State, with the consent of the Treasury, otherwise directs.
- (3) Any sums received by the Secretary of State under sub-paragraph (1) shall be paid into the Consolidated Fund.
