- (2) The governing body shall not make [F12 any disposal to which this paragraph applies] without the written consent of the [F13 Assembly].
- (3) Where the governing body apply to the [F14Assembly] for [F15its] consent to any such disposal [F16and [F17the Assembly] decides to give that consent], [F17the Assembly] may do one or more of the following, namely—
