

National Minimum Wage Act 1998

1998 CHAPTER 39

Special classes of person

37 Armed forces.

- (1) A person serving as a member of the naval, military or air forces of the Crown does not qualify for the national minimum wage in respect of that service.
- (2) Section 36 above applies to employment by an association established for the purposes of Part XI of the MIReserve Forces Act 1996, notwithstanding anything in subsection (1) above.
