STANDARD AUTHORISATIONS: REVIEW

Records

- 121 A supervisory body must keep a written record of the following information—
- (a) each request for a review that is made to them;
 - (b) the outcome of each request;
 - (c) each review which they carry out;
 - (d) the outcome of each review which they carry out;
 - (e) any variation of an authorisation made in consequence of a review.]
