INTERPRETATION

Hospitals and their managing authorities

- [^{F2}177 “Managing authority”, in relation to an independent hospital, means—
- (a) in relation to England, the person registered, or required to be registered, under Chapter 2 of Part 1 of the Health and Social Care Act 2008 in respect of regulated activities (within the meaning of that Part) carried on in the hospital, and
 - (b) in relation to Wales, the person registered, or required to be registered, under Part 2 of the Care Standards Act 2000 in respect of the hospital.]]^{F2}
