##### INTERPRETATION

###### *Supervisory bodies: hospitals*

- 181 (1) The identity of the supervisory body is determined under this paragraph in cases where the relevant hospital is situated in Wales.
- (2) The National Assembly for Wales are the supervisory body.
- [<sup>F2</sup>(3) But if the relevant person is ordinarily resident in the area of a local authority in England, the supervisory body are that local authority.
- (4) “ Local authority ” means—
- (a) the council of a county;
  - (b) the council of a district for which there is no county council;
  - (c) the council of a London borough;
  - (d) the Common Council of the City of London;
  - (e) the Council of the Isles of Scilly.]]
