STANDARD AUTHORISATIONS

Supervisory body to give authorisation

- 23 The managing authority may not make a request for a standard authorisation unless—
- (a) they are required to do so by paragraph 24 (as read with paragraphs 27 to 29),

 - (c) they are permitted to do so by paragraph 30.]
