Variation of conditions ground

- 107 (1) The best interests requirement is reviewable on the ground that
 - there has been a change in the relevant person's case, and
 - because of that change, it would be appropriate to vary the conditions to (b) which the standard authorisation is subject.
 - (2) This ground is referred to as the variation of conditions ground.
 - (3) A reference to varying the conditions to which the standard authorisation is subject is a reference to-
 - (a) amendment of an existing condition,
 - omission of an existing condition, or (b)
 - inclusion of a new condition (whether or not there are already any existing (c) conditions).]
