### Accounts

- 40 (1) The Commission shall—
  - (a) keep proper accounting records, and
  - (b) prepare a statement of accounts in respect of each financial year in such form as the [F1Secretary of State] may direct.
  - (2) The Commission shall send a copy of a statement under sub-paragraph (1)(b) to—
    - (a) the [F1Secretary of State], and
    - (b) the Comptroller and Auditor General.
  - (3) A copy of a statement must be sent under sub-paragraph (2) within such period, beginning with the end of the financial year to which the statement relates, as the [F1Secretary of State] may direct.
  - (4) The Comptroller and Auditor General shall—
    - (a) examine, certify and report on a statement received under this paragraph, and
    - (b) lay a copy of the statement and his report before Parliament.
  - (5) The [F1Secretary of State] may make a direction under sub-paragraph (1)(b) only with the consent of the Treasury.
