Gender reassignment: Scotland

- (1) An approved celebrant (A) does not contravene section 29, so far as relating to gender reassignment discrimination, only by refusing to solemnise the marriage of a person
 (B) if A reasonably believes that B's gender has become the acquired gender under the Gender Recognition Act 2004.
 - (2) In sub-paragraph (1) "approved celebrant" has the meaning given in section 8(2)(a) of the Marriage (Scotland) Act 1977 (persons who may solemnise marriage).
 - [F2(3) An approved celebrant (A) does not contravene section 29, so far as relating to gender reassignment discrimination, only by refusing to register the civil partnership of a person (B) if A reasonably believes that B's gender has become the acquired gender under the Gender Recognition Act 2004.
 - (4) In sub-paragraph (3) "approved celebrant" has the meaning given in section 94A(4) (a) of the Civil Partnership Act 2004.]
