Controls on activities in Parliament Square [FIetc]

146 Power of court on conviction

- (1) The court may do either or both of the following on the conviction of a person ("P") of an offence under section 143—
 - (a) make an order providing for the forfeiture of any item of a kind mentioned in subsection (2) of that section that was used in the commission of the offence;
 - (b) make such other order as the court considers appropriate for the purpose of preventing P from engaging in any prohibited activity in [FI a relevant area].
- (2) An order under subsection (1)(b) may (in particular) require P not to enter [F2 a relevant area] for such period as may be specified in the order.
- [F3(2A) In this section "relevant area" means an area consisting of either or both of the following areas—
 - (a) the controlled area of Parliament Square, and
 - (b) the Palace of Westminster controlled area.]
 - (3) Power of the court to make an order under this section is in addition to the court's power to impose a fine under section 143(8).
