#### DEPRIVATION AND DRIVING DISQUALIFICATION ORDERS: MINOR AND CONSEQUENTIAL AMENDMENTS

##### *Armed Forces Act 2006*

- 10 In Schedule 3 (civilians etc: modifications of Court Martial sentencing powers)—
- (a) in paragraph 2—
    - (i) for “12” substitute “14”;
    - (ii) for “7” substitute “9”;
  - (b) in paragraph 4—
    - (i) for “12”, in each place it occurs, substitute “14”;
    - (ii) for “10”, in each place it occurs, substitute “12”.
