PAVEMENT LICENCES

Applications: fees

- 3 (1) Section 2 of the 2020 Act (applications) is amended as follows.
- (2) In subsection (1)(c), for “£100” substitute “the relevant amount”.
- (3) After subsection (1) insert—
- “**(1A)** In subsection (1)(c), “the relevant amount” means—
- (a) £350, in the case of an application which—
- (i) is made by a person who already holds a pavement licence,
and
- (ii) is in respect of the premises to which that existing licence
relates (whether or not it is a renewal application), and
- (b) £500, in any other case.
- (1B)** The Secretary of State may by regulations amend subsection (1A)(a) or (b) so
as to substitute a different amount for the amount for the time being specified
there.”
