- [F3(1) For the purposes of subsection (8) of section twenty-one of the M1 National Assistance Act 1948 (which restricts the duties of local authorities in respect of the provision of accommodation under that section by reference to the provision authorised or required to be made under other enactments) no account shall be taken of the provision authorised or required to be made by [F4 local social services authorities] under [F5 paragraph 2 of Schedule 8 to the M2 National Health Service Act 1977], with respect to residential accommodation for persons who are or have been suffering from mental disorder.]



142 Default powers of Minister.

(1) Where the Minister is of opinion, on complaint or otherwise, that a [F57] local social services authority] have failed to carry out functions conferred or imposed on the authority by or under this Act or have in carrying out those functions failed to comply with any regulations relating thereto, he may after such inquiry as he thinks fit make an order declaring the authority to be in default.
