## 1 Extension of Colonial Probates Act, 1892, to certain protected states and mandated territories.

The power of His Majesty to apply the <sup>M1</sup>Colonial Probates Act, 1892, to British possessions shall include a power to apply the said Act to any territories, being either territories under His Majesty's protection or territories in respect of which a mandate on behalf of the League of Nations has been accepted by His Majesty, to which it cannot be applied by virtue of the provisions of the <sup>M2</sup>Foreign Jurisdiction Acts, 1890 <sup>M3</sup>and 1913, and the said Act shall accordingly have effect as if references therein to British possessions included references to such territories as aforesaid.
