An Act to regulate certain Offices of the House of Commons. [28th February 1856]

1 †Appointment of clerk assistant confirmed, and future clerks assistant to be appointed by Her Majesty.

..... ^{F1} the clerk assistant and second clerk assistant of the House of Commons respectively shall be appointed by Her Majesty, by warrant under her Royal Sign Manual; and every clerk assistant and second clerk assistant shall be removable only by Her Majesty, upon an address of the House of Commons to Her Majesty for that purpose.
