The Occupational Pension Schemes (Equal Treatment) Regulations 1995

The Secretary of State for Social Security, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by sections 63(5), 64(2) and (3), 66(4), 124(1) and 174(2) and (3) of the Pensions Act 1995(1) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, by this instrument, which is made before the end of the period of 6 months beginning with the coming into force of those provisions of Part I of that Act by virtue of which it is made(2), hereby makes the following Regulations:—

⁽²⁾ See section 120 of the Act which provides that the Secretary of State must consult such persons as he considers appropriate before making regulations by virtue of the provisions in Part I of that Act.
