Notices of exemption

- **2.**—(1) The prescribed notice of exemption for the purposes of [F1 section 171(4)(b) of the Act] shall be a notice duly completed in accordance with the certificate of exemption, which shall be—
 - (a) in the case of a driver of a private hire vehicle to whom the [F2 exemption certificate] has been issued by a licensing authority in England, the notice set out in Schedule 1 to these Regulations; and
 - (b) in the case of a driver of a private hire vehicle to whom the [F3 exemption certificate] has been issued by a licensing authority in Wales, the notice set out in Schedule 2 to these Regulations.
- [F4(2)] The prescribed manner of exhibiting a notice of exemption for the purposes of [F5section 171(4)(b) of the Act] shall be—
 - (a) by displaying it-
 - (i) on the nearside of and immediately behind the windscreen of the private hire vehicle facing outwards; and
 - (ii) in a manner that readily permits its removal;
 - (b) so that—
 - (i) its front is clearly visible from the outside of the private hire vehicle; and
 - (ii) its back is clearly visible from the driver's seat of the private hire vehicle.]
