**The Sexual Offences Act 2003 (Commencement) Order 2004**

*Made - - - - 23rd March 2004*

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 141(1) of the Sexual Offences Act 2003 (1), hereby makes the following Order:

**Citation and extent**

- 1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Sexual Offences Act 2003 (Commencement) Order 2004.
- (2) This Order does not extend to Scotland.

**Commencement**

2. The Sexual Offences Act 2003 shall come into force on 1st May 2004 in so far as it is not already in force.
