Consequential amendments

Social Security (Payments on account, Overpayments and Recovery) Regulations 1988

44. In regulation 1(2) of the Social Security (Payments on account, Overpayments and Recovery) Regulations 1988⁽¹⁾ (citation, commencement and interpretation) in the definition of “adjudicating authority” for the words “an appeal tribunal” to the end substitute “the First-tier Tribunal or the Upper Tribunal;”.
