**The Bribery Act 2010 (Commencement) Order 2011**

*Made* - - - -

*7th June 2011*

The Secretary of State makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 19(1) of the Bribery Act 2010<sup>(1)</sup>. Before doing so, in accordance with section 19(4) of that Act, the Secretary of State has consulted the Scottish Ministers<sup>(2)</sup>.

**Citation**

1. This Order may be cited as the Bribery Act 2010 (Commencement) Order 2011.

**Commencement**

2. The Bribery Act 2010 comes into force on 1st July 2011 to the extent that it is not already in force.
