**The Postal Services (Appeals to the Competition Commission)
(Investigations and Extension of Time Limits) Order 2011**

Application of sections 109 to 117 of the 2002 Act

3. The following sections of Part 3 of the 2002 Act shall apply, as modified by Article 4, in relation to any appeal made to [^{F1}CMA] under section 59 of the Act—

- (a) section 109 (attendance of witnesses and production of documents etc);
- (b) section 110 (enforcement of powers under section 109: general);
- (c) section 111 (penalties);
- (d) section 112 (penalties: main procedural requirements);
- (e) section 113 (payments and interest by instalments);
- (f) section 114 (appeals in relation to penalties);
- (g) section 115 (recovery of penalties);
- (h) section 116 (statement of policy); and
- (i) section 117 (false or misleading documents).
