[^{F1}Consequential modifications of sections 99 and 101J of the 1993 Act

18D.—(1) The 1993 Act has effect subject to the following modifications.

(2) Where regulation 18C of these Regulations applies in relation to an application under section 95(1) (ways of taking right to cash equivalent), section 99(2)(b) (trustees' duties after exercise of option) has effect as if the duty it imposes only applies if, within the 6-month period to which it refers, the requirements under that regulation for proceeding with the application have been satisfied.

(3) Where regulation 18C of these Regulations applies in relation to the requirement under section 101G(4) (restrictions on power to give transfer notice) for a member to make an application under section 95(1) in addition to giving a transfer notice, section 101J(1)(b) (time for compliance with transfer notice) has effect as if the duty it imposes only applies if, within the 6-month period to which it refers, the requirements under that regulation for proceeding with the application have been satisfied.]
