The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by section 183(1), (7) and (9) of the Policing and Crime Act 2017(a).

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Policing and Crime Act 2017 (Commencement No. 5 and Transitional Provisions) (Amendment) Regulations 2017 and come into force on 30th November 2017.

Amendments to the Policing and Crime Act 2017 (Commencement No. 5 and Transitional Provisions) Regulations 2017

2.—(1) The Policing and Crime Act 2017 (Commencement No. 5 and Transitional Provisions) Regulations 2017(b) are amended as follows.

These Regulations are necessary to correct an error in the Commencement (No. 5) Regulations.
