**The Financial Guidance and Claims Act 2018  
(Commencement No. 2) Regulations 2018**

The Treasury make the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by section 37(5) and (9)(b)(i) of the Financial Guidance and Claims Act 2018(1):

**Citation**

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Financial Guidance and Claims Act 2018 (Commencement No. 2) Regulations 2018.

**Appointed Days**

2. The day appointed for the coming into force of the following provisions of the Financial Guidance and Claims Act 2018 is—

- (a) 1st October 2018 for section 14 (levy under FSMA 2000 for debt advice expenses of devolved authorities); and
- (b) 1st January 2019 for section 20 (FCA general rules: information about the availability of guidance).
