(Amendment) (EU Exit) Regulations 2018**

**PART 2**

Amendment of subordinate legislation

**Amendment of the Rail Passengers Rights and Obligations (Designation and Enforcement) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2017**

4. The Rail Passengers Rights and Obligations (Designation and Enforcement) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2017<sup>(1)</sup> are amended as follows—

- (a) in regulation 2, at the end of the definition of “Regulation 1371/2007” insert “as amended by the Rail Passengers’ Rights and Obligations (Amendment) (EU Exit) Regulations 2018”;
- (b) for regulation 4(1), substitute—

“(1) The Department for Infrastructure<sup>(2)</sup> is the body responsible for the enforcement of Regulation 1371/2007.”;
- (c) for regulation 5(1), substitute—

“(1) The Consumer Council<sup>(3)</sup> is the designated body to which any passenger may submit a complaint about an alleged contravention of Regulation 1371/2007.”;
- (d) in regulation 7, omit “For the purposes of Article 32 of Regulation 1371/2007”.
