**The Wales Act 2017 (Consequential and Saving Provisions) Regulations 2018**

**Police and Crime Commissioner Elections Order 2012**

4. In article 2 (interpretation)—
- (a) for the definition of “register of electors” substitute—
    - ““register of electors” means—
    - (a) in relation to a PCC election in England the register of local government electors<sup>(1)</sup>;
    - (b) in relation to a PCC election in Wales—
      - (i) the register of parliamentary electors, excluding any entry included in pursuance of an overseas elector’s declaration<sup>(2)</sup>; and
      - (ii) in the case of peers disqualified from voting as an elector at parliamentary elections and relevant citizens of the Union<sup>(3)</sup> who will have attained the age of 18 on the date of the poll, the register of local government electors;”;
  - (b) omit the definition of “relevant citizen of the Union”.

(2) There is a definition of overseas elector’s declaration in section 102 of the Police Reform and Social Responsibility Act 2011 (c. 13).  
(3) There is a definition of relevant citizens of the Union in section 102 of the Police Reform and Social Responsibility Act 2011 (c. 13).
