The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries in pursuance of the powers conferred upon him by Sections 13 (2) and 14 of the Agricultural Marketing Act, 1931, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

- 1. Regulation 1 of the Agricultural Marketing (Loans) (England) Regulations, 1932,(a) shall be amended by deleting in the definition of "loan" therein, the word "only".
- 2. These Regulations may be cited as "The Agricultural Marketing (Loans) (England) Amending Regulations, 1933."
