In exercise of the powers conferred on him by the Agricultural Produce 18 & 19 Geo. (Grading and Marking) Acts, 1928 and 1931, the Minister of Agriculture 5. c. 19. and Fisheries hereby makes the following Regulations:-

1. A grade designation to indicate the quality of Lancashire cheese Prescription made from cows' milk produced in England and Wales shall be as of grade follows :---

and the quality indicated by such grade designation shall be deemed to be the quality as described in the First Schedule hereto.

The grade designation mark shall be the the grade designation Prescription specified in Regulation 1 above associated with the words "Empire of grade Buying Begins at Home," and with the following mark, namely, a map designation of England and Wales in silhouette with the words "Produce of England mark. and Wales" inscribed in a circle placed centrally in the map within which circle is a design representing the Union Jack, and which is more particularly described in the Second Schedule hereto.

3. In any certificate issued by the National Mark Committee under Construction the Agricultural Produce (Grading and Marking) (General) Regulations, of certificates 1928,(a) authorizing the marking of Lancashire cheese with the grade of authorizadesignation mark prescribed by the regulations hereby revoked, references tion. to the said Regulations shall be construed as references to these Regulations.

4. These Regulations shall come into operation on the 20th September, Date of 1937, on which date the Agricultural Produce (Grading and Marking) coming into (Lancashire Cheese) Regulations, 1936, (b) shall be revoked, but without operation prejudice to anything done thereunder before the date of coming into and revocaoperation of these Regulations.

5. These Regulations may be cited as the Agricultural Produce Short title. (Grading and Marking) (Lancashire Cheese) Regulations, 1937.

SCHEDULE I

LANCASHIRE CHEESE MADE FROM COWS' MILK PRODUCED IN ENGLAND AND WALES: DEFINITION OF QUALITY OF

SELECTED GRADE

General Requirements		The cheese shall be a hard-pressed cheese made from full-cream cows' milk, and shall contain a minimum of 45 per cent. of butter fat in the moisture-free substance.
Special Requirements	Colour	The cheese shall be of uniform colour throughout, not deeper than cream.
	Finish and Appearance	Rind smooth, intact, not dry or hard. Bandages and caps clean, and neatly sewn. Depth of the cheese shall be not less than half the diameter.
	Texture and Body	Texture open, buttery, somewhat friable. Body moderately firm without being weak. Free from gas holes.
	Flavour	Clean and mild.
	Minimum Age at time of Grading	10 days.
