**The Anti-social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014 (Commencement No. 2 and Transitional Provisions) (Wales) Order 2014**

**Transitional provision in relation to the coming into force of sections 94 and 97 in Wales**

**3.** In relation to the coming into force of sections 94 and 97 (absolute grounds for possession) in Wales, condition 5 in section 84A(7) of the Housing Act 1985<sup>(1)</sup> and condition 5 in Ground 7A of Part 1 of Schedule 2 to the Housing Act 1988<sup>(2)</sup> is only met if the offence under—

- (a) section 80(4) of the Environmental Protection Act 1990<sup>(3)</sup> (breach of abatement notice in relation to statutory nuisance), or
- (b) section 82(8) of that Act (breach of court order to abate statutory nuisance etc.),

is committed by the tenant, or a person residing in or visiting the dwelling-house, on or after 20 October 2014.
